

Darrell Gardner Scholarship 2020 Application Guidelines

Background:

The Darrell Gardner Scholarship offers one \$1000.00 scholarship award to Emery County students. The goal is to provide financial aid to students who have demonstrated competency in academics, community involvement and a desire to further his/her education that will ultimately benefit Emery County.

Because of limited funds, Emery Scholarship Fund will give priority to applicants who have not been awarded other scholarships or educational financial grants.

The scholarship money can only be used for tuition, school fees and books. It will be sent directly to the school in which the student is or will be attending. Money not used by the end of four years will be forfeited and returned to the Emery Scholarship Fund with no opportunity for reclamation.

Eligibility requirements:

- Must be a citizen or a legal resident of the United States.
- Any college-bound high school senior residing in Emery County may apply for the scholarship.
- Must have been on the track team at some point during high school.

Application requirements:

- Must fully complete the provided application form.
- Must provide three references – one personal/community and two school. The reference must include name, address and telephone number.
- Must provide a one-page typed essay (between 400 and 500 words) describing:
 1. How receiving this scholarship will aid you in achieving your long-term educational and career goals.
 2. Darrell's example was to work hard even when you're against the odds. How will you apply this statement to the rest of your own life?
 3. Your future plans to contribute back to your community.
